Keynote Address //



The General Overseer, Pastor (Dr.) Elijah O. Abina's Keynote Address on the occasion of the Second Annual Convention of The Gospel Faith Mission International (GOFAMINT) Canada, from Friday, June 26 – Sunday, June 28, 2026

Dearly beloved brethren in Christ, grace and peace of the Lord be multiplied unto you. I bring you warm Calvary greetings from the members of the Executive Council in Nigeria and the entire GOFAMINT family worldwide on this occasion of your second Annual Convention of GOFAMINT in Canada.

It is with deep gratitude to God that I stand before you today at the opening of this Convention under the theme: "Building According to the Pattern."

This theme is very profound and timely. Some of the theme's anchor scriptures call us back to a central truth: God is not casual about how His work is done. But He is intentional, precise, and purposeful, and He expects the same from us.

In Exodus 25:40, for instance, He instructed Moses: "See that you make them according to the pattern shown you on the mountain." Hebrews 8:5 also reminds us that earthly service must reflect heavenly realities. These are not just suggestions but orders to follow.

In fact, 1 Corinthians 3 tells us that a solid and sure foundation has been laid, and we must build on it only as befitting that foundation, with gold, silver, and precious stones, and not with wood and hay and straw materials.

I, therefore, want to use the opportunity of this Convention to urge you to follow God's pattern in living your personal life and in Church affairs. The Church is not a human invention. It is God's design. You are, therefore, not to embark on building a spiritual house with worldly tools. Our doctrines, our worship, and the ways we run the church must all align with heaven's blueprint, not with worldly ways, cultural trends, or personal preferences.

So, this convention should not be seen as business as usual. But it should be a time of sober reflection and realignment with the biblical order upon which our Church, The Gospel Faith Mission International, was established. It should be a time to reflect on our Core Values, our Statement of Purpose, and the Membership Covenants, with the aim of remaining aligned with the ancient landmarks set by the early Church and the founding fathers of GOFAMINT. We should earnestly contend for the faith which was once for all delivered to us without veering from the laid down pattern. This is especially so, as everything around us today clearly signals that the return of the Lord is much closer than ever before.

Therefore, we must make every effort to ensure that we build our Christian lives according to the pattern laid down, while being mindful of the kind of materials we use in the building of the Kingdom, knowing full well that our work will be 'revealed' by the fire test (1 Corinthians 3:10-15; 2 Corinthians 5:10).

We should make the necessary adjustments to our lifestyle of service and to our commitment to the values of purity, righteousness, and consecration, which are fast fading away in Christendom today.

I, therefore, beseech you all to seriously work with the theme of this Convention for our revival and in order to birth a Church that befits the bride of Christ that is holy, having no spot or blemish .

It is my sincere desire that you will participate fully and actively in all the sessions of this great Convention because I know that the Holy Spirit is here to perform all manner of signs and wonders in the name of our Lord, Jesus Christ. I believe that your coming is not going to be in vain, as the Lord God will meet you at the very point of your need and perfect all that concerns you in the course of this great gathering in Jesus' name.

I want to conclude my address by inviting you to the 60th Annual International Convention and the grand 70th anniversary of the founding of GOFAMINT, taking place at our International Gospel City in Ogunmakin, Ogun State, Nigeria, from the 3rd to the 9th of August 2026.

Brethren in the Lord, I commend you unto the grace of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ to keep you safe and sound in His will till the day of His return. I wish you a very wonderful time in the presence of God throughout this glorious Convention in the name of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

PASTOR SUNDAY ADU – Assistance General Overseer Foreign Missions Gofamint Worldwide

Pastor Sunday Adu is an anointed man of God who teaches the word of God with simplicity and clarity to bring about the progressive perfection of the saints by the realization and actualization of their potentials in God. He has a mandate from God to eliminate ignorance by the manifold wisdom of God, and that is responsible for his insatiable passion for knowledge. He is known for his anointed messages on wisdom, holiness, restoration, identity, and apostolicity (He firmly believes that when the fivefold ministry gifts are in full operation, it brings permanent explosion to the church). These messages have taken him to nations, and he believes God for more open doors to make the mystery of God's word known to all men. Called into the ministry on October 28, 1984, under an overwhelming influence of the Holy Spirit with a mandate to take the gospel to nations of the world, the vision is gradually coming into fulfillment. Presently, he is the Resident Pastor of GOFAMINT House of Hope, Brentwood, MD, USA, and the Assistant General Overseer (Foreign Missions) for GOFAMINT Worldwide. Pastor S. J.
